

Subject: VN Ukraine Team Meeting #10

This will be the last team meeting I will send out via e-mail. If you have not called me, please do so. I want to speak to everyone over the phone before we leave.

There are a few things I need to cover in this last team meeting e-mail.

Accommodations

First, our accommodations have changed. The place we are now staying is called Bila Dubrava. The showers are more dorm-like than we expected, so we are asking everyone to bring a plastic shower curtain with them, with the rings, or two if you like, just to ensure privacy in the showers.

Currency Exchange

Please bring new, crisp clean bills with you for currency exchange, which we will do in Kyiv. They will not take dirty or old bills.

Phone Cards

We have done some research on the issue of the telephone cards and the Ukrainians know what kind we need to get and where they are available. Expect to pay around \$5-\$10 for a phone card that will last you between 30 minutes and 1 hour MAXIMUM.

Please let your family and friends know that you will contact them as soon as you can, however, it may be a day or two after our arrival before we will be able to call home. Please let them know that they will be contacted as soon as we possibly can.
